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Statement regarding the Regulation of PFAS under REACH-Regulation (EU) Nr. 1907/2006

Thank you for your inquiry regarding the planned regulation of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) under the REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006.

At E+E Elektronik, we are strongly committed to compliance with regulatory requirements and industry standards relating to occupational safety and environmental protection. We closely monitor the ongoing regulatory developments concerning the proposed PFAS restriction under REACH and are preparing to implement any future legal requirements within the prescribed timelines.

Information regarding the possible presence of PFAS in components used in our products is based on information provided by our suppliers. As a downstream user, we are currently unable to make binding statements regarding individual components. Whether and to what extent specific components will be affected by future restrictions will depend on the relevant substance groups, chemical compounds, and the applicable legal provisions.

Based on the current ECHA restriction proposal, we expect a transition period of up to 13.5 years for the components we use.

Nevertheless, we are already taking steps to avoid the use of PFAS wherever technically feasible. In the development of new products, we aim to implement PFAS-free designs whenever technically equivalent alternatives are available. Where required due to legal requirements, technical considerations, or component availability, affected components can be replaced by suitable alternatives. In doing so, we ensure compliance with all applicable legal requirements as well as the specified product performance and quality characteristics.
